As we wrote to you last year, the University retained Debevoise & Plimpton LLP to investigate reports of sexual misconduct by Dr. Archibald. We also indicated that we would share with you the investigation's conclusions. Debevoise has completed its investigation and issued a report, which protects patient privacy and does not identify any patient. The entire report will be made available on the morning of May 23 at: ArchibaldReport.com.

We are extremely grateful to those who came forward to share their experiences. At the same time, we respect the decision of others who decided not to do so.

We profoundly apologize to those patients who experienced pain and suffering as a result of Dr. Archibald's reprehensible conduct.

We want to reassure you of our commitment to the safety and well-being of our patients. To this end, patient protections and safeguards have been continually enhanced at the Hospital over the past decades. We also reaffirm our commitment to providing support to Dr. Archibald's former patients for counseling services through the Rockefeller Hospital Therapy Fund, which is operated in partnership with RAINN (Rape, Abuse & Incest National Network).
